## Juror's Statement

The Fine Arts League of Cary has many excellent artists in its membership. The work jurored into the 2010 exhibition included primarily paintings and photography with some three-dimensional work, mixed media work, drawings and fiber pieces. From over 300 pieces, 70 works were chosen.

My criteria for choosing work to be included in the exhibition began with evidence of strong design qualities within the composition. I looked for professional handling and use of media and processes, as well as a mature, developed artistic style. Lastly, I looked for an elusive quality that goes beyond content, media, technique and style, which speaks on a different level and invites the viewer to explore, ask questions and become personally involved with the artwork.

Juroring any exhibition is an enjoyable experience. I certainly became personally involved with all the pieces in the exhibition as I studied the compositions. It was a pleasure to see all the artistic activity in the area and the work of so many dedicated artists who make our community such a culturally rich place to live.
