## ***Fine Arts League of Cary Presents 31st Annual Juried Exhibition***

**Submissions to Premier Regional Art Show April 15-June 15**

**Exhibit Opens June 30 at Page-Walker Arts & History Center**

**CARY, NC** — The Fine Arts League of Cary (FALC) proudly announces the 31st Annual Juried Exhibition (AJE), one of the region’s most competitive and respected showcases of fine art. Open to artists across North Carolina and neighboring states, the AJE consistently draws hundreds of submissions, with only the highest-caliber works selected for exhibition.

Submissions for the 2026 AJE will be accepted April 15 through June 15, 2026. Artists may find entry requirements and more information on the [FALC website](#).

The exhibition will be on view June 30 through September 14, 2026, in the Page-Walker Arts & History Center galleries in downtown Cary. Admission is free and open to the public during regular gallery hours.

The AJE features two-dimensional works spanning a wide range of media, styles, and genres—from abstract to realism—offering visitors a compelling look at contemporary artistic talent across the region. All of the exhibited works will be available for purchase.

Last year’s exhibition drew more than 650 entries from over 230 artists, with only 70 works selected—an indication of both the exhibition’s prestige and the exceptional quality of submissions.

This year’s exhibition will be juried by Chapel Hill artist Lynn Sanguedolce, and FALC will award a total of \$2,500 in prizes.

A free public reception will be held on Sunday, August 2, 2026, from 2:00–4:00 pm, offering guests the opportunity to meet participating artists.

## More Fine Arts League of Cary Events

The Fine Arts League hosts many art events throughout the year, including:

**March 5 – August 15: Joy! Exhibit at the Fine Arts League of Cary Gallery.** What brings joy to an artist? The Fine Arts League of Cary invited artists to answer this question through their work in the exhibition *Joy!* Eighty-five works were selected for exhibition — moments in nature, beloved pets, cherished memories, and simple everyday beauty, each offering a personal glimpse into what inspires and uplifts the creative spirit. The gallery is located at 110 E. Park St., Cary.

**May 6 - 27: Wake Teen Arts Exhibition, presented by Cary Family Dental.** Now in its 16th year, the exhibition celebrates the creative excellence of high-school artists in Wake County and supports the tireless work of their teachers. Prizes for art students and their teachers total \$20,000, including FALC, Jerry's Artarama, and Cary Visual Arts awards, as well as Meredith College scholarships. A public reception and awards ceremony will take place May 10 from 2:00 - 4:00 pm at the Frankie Weems Gallery at Meredith College.

**May 20 – June 14: Fabulous Fakes at the Cary Arts Center.** The Fabulous Fakes exhibition showcases works by Fine Arts League of Cary artists who recreate or reinterpret famous masterpieces—ranging from faithful replicas to inventive, original works inspired by the masters. The exhibit culminates in an awards reception on May 29 (6:00 – 8:00 pm), including a People's Choice award—so come see the show and vote for your favorite.

**July 13, 2026 – January 6, 2027: Abstracts and Expressions.** Experience a dynamic showcase of art at The Mayton in downtown Cary, where the first floor is dedicated to the work of FALC Master Artists and the second and third floors feature *Abstracts and Expressions*, a vibrant exhibit by member artists. With more than 150 works on display, this multi-level exhibition offers a rich exploration of style, creativity, and expression, with all pieces available for purchase.

**October 14 - 18: Fine Arts League of Cary Art Swarm.** Art Swarm brings many of the region's most accomplished artists to both outdoor and indoor venues throughout downtown Cary. The public is invited to observe the creative process, engage with the artists, and create art of their own. In addition to plein air painting, Art Swarm features indoor studio work, hands-on workshops, collaborative community art projects, an art sale, exhibition, and awards ceremony.
